- Deuteronomy is an interpretation of the past
- It is also an interpretation of the Law
- Moses wants present generation to profit from failures of the past



God is Source of the Nation

- God wanted Moses to teach them the proper relationship of the meaning of grace
- Notice the word “Give”

God Gave Them The Land

- Deuteronomy 9:4-6
- The problem for them throughout the OT was they thought they deserved the land because of the blood of Abraham running through their veins.



God Gave Them Canaan

- The Nations in Canaan were wicked because of sin
- That was God's judgment against sin
- Just as God sent Moses to preach to Egypt, Israel was to be a light to Canaan



Deuteronomy Shows God's Love

- Their response should be to love God and obey him
- The word “do” is the proper response to God's grace
- Moses stresses the words “teach, hear, and learn
